Public Health's H1N1 Vaccination Clinics

Public Health—Idaho North Central District is providing H1N1 vaccinations free of charge to target populations defined by the Centers for Disease Control. Children over the age of 6 months are eligible for vaccination, as are those who provide care for them. If you would like to have your child vaccinated, or if you are in one of the target groups, please come to the Public Health H1N1 Vaccination Clinic at 215 10th Street on the following dates:

Saturday, November 21, 11:00 A.M.—2:00 P.M.

Wednesday, December 2, 3:00—6:00 P.M.

Target Populations Groups Include:

- Pregnant women
- Household contacts and caregivers for children less than 6 months of age
- Children and young adults 6 months through 24 years of age
- Health care and emergency medical services personnel
- Persons aged 25 through 64 who have health conditions associated with higher risk of medical complications from influenza
